Expectations for parents on drop-off/pick up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ FOR FAMILIES WITH MULTIPLE CHILDREN we request that you collect children from the estate side of the school (Seals, Dolphins, Seahorses, Sharks, Hermit Crabs) before proceeding to collect children from the Moor Lane side of the school (Starfish, Lobsters, Reception & Nursery). ✓ Please see the map below. Entry is from the estate gate and after dropping-off/collection, parents should exit via the carpark onto Moor Lane. ✓ On arriving at school, please wait in the area by the shelter. Parents should send their children in from the school playground once the staff call them. ✓ Please wait 2m apart from other parents. ✓ Only one adult should drop-off and collect per family ✓ NO PARENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE SCHOOL BUILDING. ✓ Please keep 2m away from members of staff. ✓ If you need to speak to a member of staff, please call the school. ✓ If there are several parents waiting, then please be patient.

Your child may like to wear additional layers of clothing under their school uniform.
