Expectations for parents on drop-off/pick up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ FOR FAMILIES WITH MULTIPLE CHILDREN we request that you collect children from the estate side of the school (Seals, Dolphins, Seahorses, Sharks, Hermit Crabs) before proceeding to collect children from the Moor Lane side of the school (Starfish, Lobsters, Reception & Nursery). ✓ Please see the map below. Entry/exit is from the library door on the Moor Lane side of the school. Parents should come down the main steps or approach through the staff car park and walk along the front of the building. After collecting their child(ren), parents should continue along by the Children's Centre to exit the school grounds. ✓ On arrival at school, please queue on the social distancing lines starting at the library doors and queuing towards the main entrance hall. ✓ Please wait 2m apart from other parents / members of staff. ✓ Only one adult should drop-off and collect per family. If possible, siblings who are not as school should be left at home. ✓ NO PARENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE SCHOOL BUILDING. ✓ If you need to speak to a member of staff, please call the school.

Other requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Book bag ✓ On days when they have PE, children can wear their PE kit to school to reduce changing needs – you will be informed of the class PE days. We would suggest that they wear black leggings/shorts/tracksuit bottoms with the PE t-shirt and their school jumper. ✓ As the school will be ventilated the temperature may be lower than usual. Your child may like to wear additional layers of clothing under their school uniform.
