## Safeguarding our Children

It is with the up – most priority that all those who come into contact with children and families at Watcombe Primary School have a duty to safeguard and promote the welfare of children.

A priority of the school is that children will learn through the curriculum how to keep themselves safe and healthy.

The Governing body is accountable for ensuring that there are effective policies and procedures in place and that these are followed.

We have four Designated safeguarding leads with responsibility for child protection these are Headteacher, Deputy Headteacher and the Family and Pastoral Mentor.

Any concern around a child's well – being **MUST** be acted on. Doing nothing is not an option. Any concerns will be discussed with the Designated Child Protection People and relevant agencies informed.
